Position Title: Community Mission Chair

Purpose: To support the Heart and Stroke Foundation of Ontario (HSFO) through lending of time and talents, in fulfilling its vision as a Foundation that, through advocacy and health partnerships, engages communities, health care providers and government to advance the health of Ontarians.

Responsibilities may include:

- Recruit and recognize a team of active volunteers to develop Mission regional plans, in partnership with the Community Mission Specialist (CMS)
- Update Chapter Council volunteers via meetings and/or email on local Mission activities
- Take an active lead at Mission Team meetings, in conjunction with the CMS
- Represent HSFO through public speaking opportunities, advocacy work with local politicians, and/or get involved as a HSFO representative with local health partnerships
- Be a resource to Mission team volunteers
