- Admitting, discharging and assessing residents;
- Carrying out doctor’s orders, including administering medications;
- In charge responsibilities include supervising PSWs and other staff;
- Responding to emergency and urgent situations as needed;
- Receiving and ensuring secure storage of medications.

- Excellent oral and written communication skills;
- Caring, patient and positive attitude;
- Exceptional organizational and time management skills;
- Professional and calm under pressure;
- Detail-oriented and extremely accurate in all work;
- Ability to handle multiple and conflicting demands in a changing environment;
